In September, the California Department of Technology released an enhanced California Enterprise Architecture Framework (CEAF), referred to as CEAF 2.0 that will assist State agencies in developing and implementing robust architectures as well as ensuring that state programs IT solutions are more closely aligned to better serve Californians.

Enterprise Architecture (EA) identifies the business processes that execute or support an organization's mission and defines how IT assets directly enable those processes. The purpose of EA is to optimize and transform the often fragmented processes, information, application systems and technologies into an efficient and integrated environment supportive of the execution of business strategy.

The CEAF 2.0 is intended to assist State agencies in defining, implementing, maintaining and using EA



effectively to support the achievement of desired business outcomes as well as to efficiently and effectively deliver government services. The CEAF 2.0 will also facilitate consistent and uniform implementation of the State's EA programs across agencies through a service-oriented approach by defining eight EA service areas. The release of the CEAF 2.0 is the first of four phases in updating the State of California's EA programs.

In addition to Mr. Muppparaju, included on the panel will be CHHS CIO and OSI Chief Deputy Shell Culp, CalTech Director Ron Hughes and CalTech Deputy Director Greg Franklin, Department of Technology Director Carlos Ramos will give opening remarks.
